

VISA INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Consular hours: 10.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. Visa collection timing: 2:00pm to 4:00pm in all working days. The Office is close on Saturday, Sunday and announced official holidays. Minimum 72 hours required for processing of visa.
- 2 All visas are issued according to the stated PURPOSE OF VISIT which must be CLEARLY STATED by the applicant. Failure to do so shall inevitably incur delays or rejection of visa.
- 3 Do check your passport whether it is valid for over 6 months from the date of the visa.
- 4 The visa if issued, only gives right to ENTER THE GAMBIA.

5 DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED

- Passport valid for at least 6 Months & Photocopy of the Passport
- Visa Application Form to be duly completed & signed along with two recent passport size photographs.
- Certificate of Yellow Fever Vaccination & photocopy of the Yellow Fever Certificate
- Sponsoring letter from Company/Employer OR Invitation letter from The Gambia as well as a three months Bank statement with a healthy amount to be able to cover your trip to The Gambia.
- Appropriate Fees (see 7)

6 An Entry Visa is granted in the following categories:

- TOURIST VISA – Granted to those who are bonafide tourist of good standing and conduct for a stay in THE GAMBIA.
- A TRANSIT VISA – For stay in THE GAMBIA for few days is granted to a person of adequate means traveling in transit thorough The Gambia to other countries. A confirmed travel documents (all tickets etc.) Showing THE GAMBIA as a point of TRANSIT.
- BUSINESS VISA – A Letter from your employer and/or business counterpart in The Gambia, if it is work related, please provide employment letter from prospective employer.
- For other purpose please submit evidence substantiating your purpose of stay.

7 VISA FEES

Duration	Entries	Fees
1 Month	Single	Rs. 8000/-
3 Months	Double	Rs. 12800/-
6 Months	Multiple	Rs. 19200/-
1 Year	Multiple	Rs. 24000/-

All fees shall be paid by CASH only. Visa Fees shall be non-refundable.

- 8 A person entering THE GAMBIA must have in his possession traveler's cheque, credit card or cash convertible money reasonable to the extent of stay.
- 9 One who applies for a kind of visa should not accept to take benefit to other kind of visa upon arrival in THE GAMBIA.

10 HEALTH REQUIREMENTS (SUBJECTS TO CHANGES)

Applicants must have a certificate of yellow fever vaccination.
